Drawbacks of VET

reduction in the number of vocational (vocational technical) training institutions and the number of students therein

the determination of young people to get higher education, the low status of VET in contrast to a diploma of a higher education institution

incomprehension of the VET prospects in the current economic environment

inadequate lack of material and technical support in many vocational (vocational technical) training institutions some migration processes

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


Conclusions

- 1. Ukraine's educational attainment level is relatively high, and VET is an essential part of the educational system, as well as VTE.
- 2. Occupations typically entered through VET and VTE are in high demand in host countries and will also be crucial for the development of Ukraine.
 - 3. Both VET and VTE systems help to overcome personal, financial, language and social barriers.
- 4. The most essential things that should be improved in Ukrainian VTE/VET systems are: preparatory programs for VET/VTE entry, recognition/validation of prior VET/VTE learning, employer support and engagement
